

# Why is the GEO on strike?

University administrators have refused to sufficiently guarantee tuition waivers.

A guarantee of current tuition waiver practice would not increase the University's costs at all.

Last year, administrators proposed stripping waivers from graduate employees with 25% FTE appointments.

This year, administrators took back the tuition waivers that they had promised to undergrad TAs in the Chemistry department.

Given the administration's refusal to guarantee current practice, the GEO fears that its next move will be to convert out-of-state to in-state waivers in some or all departments.

**Changes to tuition waiver practice would have drastically negative results for both graduate employees and the University.**
